NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The series will be governed by the 'rules' as defined in the *Racing Rules of Sailing 2017-2020*.
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations shall apply.
Keel Boats & Multihulls - Part II Category 5. Trailer Boats & Sport Boats – Part V Category B, in addition keels shall be locked down at all time while racing.
In accordance with YNZ Safety Regulations Part II 3.2, a declaration of safety compliance will be required in the entry form.
- 1.3 Rule 52 'Manual Power' Shall not Apply.
- 1.4 From sunset to sunrise International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea will apply.
- 1.5 A boat shall not discharge rubbish into the water.

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 The series is open to all Keelboats and Trailer Boats.
- 2.2 Advanced Pre-Xmas series entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of 1700 hrs Friday 13th October 2017 and New Year series will be accepted until the normal closing date of 1700 hrs Friday 26th January 2018 by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$130.00 (each series) and submitting to The Race Secretary, Bucklands Beach Yacht Club, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Auckland 2144.
- 2.3 Single entries will be accepted until the normal closing date of 1600 hrs on the day of the race by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$20.00 for BBYC members and \$25.00 for non members and submitting to The Race Secretary, Bucklands Beach Yacht Club, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Auckland 2144.
- 2.4 To be eligible to complete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the skipper's national authority.
- 2.5 J 24 crewed races, J 24's that are racing must have a senior qualified sailor on board each boat or else arrangements must be made to have a separate patrol boat accompanying the J 24's.
- 2.6 After the first race of the series any change of trim, sails, spars, variation to hull, rudder, keel or propeller must be declared on BBYC Declaration Form and lodged with BBYC Office by 1000 hrs on the day of the race.

3. SCHEDULE OF EVENTS:

- 3.1 Each series Pre-Xmas and New Year will consist of 9 races on Wednesday, commencing on Wednesday 18th October 2017 for Pre Xmas and commencing on Wednesday 31st January 2018 for the New Year.
- 3.2 The first warning signal for Wednesday will be 1825 hrs.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions are contained in the BBYC 2017/2018 Yearbook (Keeler & Trailer Boat General Sailing Instructions). Single entries and non-members are required to pick up their Sailing Instructions from the BBYC Office between 0900 hrs and 1700 hrs weekdays.

5. RACING AREA:

All races will be conducted in the area bound by North Head Racing Buoy and Waiheke Island.

6. COURSES TO BE SAILED:

The courses will be 5 Harbour Courses and 4 Windward/Leeward Courses. (Contained in the BBYC 2017/2018 Yearbook – General Course Sheet). Single entries and non-members are required to pick up their General Course Sheet from the BBYC Office between 0900 hrs and 1700 hrs weekdays.

7. SCORING:

- 7.1 The Low Points Scoring System of Appendix A will apply.
- 7.2 Four races will be required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 7.3 (a) When fewer than 6 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores
(b) When from 6 to 7 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worse score.
(c) When 8 races have been completed a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worse scores.
- 7.4 Series results for each race will be counted in respect of boats entered only for the series. Individual entries shall be excluded when allocating points for the series.

8. PRIZES:

- 8.1 Prize allocation will be at the discretion of the Race Committee for each event.
- 8.2 Weekly prize vouchers for each division will be presented at the post race function held at the B.B.Y.C. Clubhouse.
- 8.3 Annual Summer Series Prize giving: Saturday 5th May 2018.
