NOTICE OF RACE

1. RULES:

- 1.1 The series/races will be governed by the 'rules' as defined on the Racing Rules of Sailing 2013 - 2016. **After 1 January 2017 use the Racing Rules of Sailing 2017 – 2020**, and including any amendments to the RRS that are issued and come into effect prior to the series commencing.
- 1.2 The YNZ Safety Regulations shall apply.
Keel Boats - Part II Category 5. Trailer Boats – Part V Category B, in addition keels shall be locked down at all times while racing. In accordance with YNZ Safety Regulations Part II 3.2, a declaration of safety compliance will be required in the entry form.
- 1.3 From sunset to sunrise International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea will apply

2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY:

- 2.1 Boats in the starting area at the 5 minute gun you will be deemed to be a starter. A minimum of **THREE** Boats must be in the Start Area at the Preparatory Signal (13:26 hrs) or the race will be Abandoned.
- 2.2 The series is open to all Keelboats and Trailer Boats.
- 2.3 Advanced series entries will be accepted until the normal closing time of 1600 hrs on Thursday 10th Nov 2016 by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$50.00 and mailing to The Race Secretary, Bucklands Beach Yacht Club, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Manukau 2144.
- 2.4 Single entries will be accepted until the normal closing time of 1600 hrs Friday prior to the race by completing the attached entry form accompanied by a fee of \$15.00 (single race) and mailing to The Race Secretary, Bucklands Beach Yacht Club, P O Box 54 005, The Marina, Manukau 2144.
- 2.5 To be eligible to complete in this series each skipper shall be a financial member of a club recognised by the skipper's national authority
- 2.6 After the first race of the series any change of trim, sails, spars, variation to hull, rudder, keel or propeller must be declared on BBYC Declaration Form and lodged with BBYC Office by 1600 hrs on the day prior to the race.

4. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS:

The Sailing Instructions are contained in the BBYC 2016/2017 Yearbook (Keeler & Trailer Boat General Sailing Instructions), Non BBYC Members will be emailed the Sailing Instructions or they can be picked from the BBYC Office between 0900 and 1600 weekdays.

5. RACING AREA:

As per the courses in the BBYC Year Book 2016/2017. - **Coldair and P&P Services Saturday Series courses.**

6. COURSES TO BE SAILED:

As per the courses in the BBYC Year Book 2016/2017. - Coldair and P&P services Saturday Series courses. Course sheet available from Race Office.

7. STARTING:

The following starting sequence shall apply:

At the 5 minute gun a large fluro pink flag will be raised

At the 4 minute gun a large fluro green flag will be raised

At the 1 minute gun the large fluro green flag will be lowered

At the start gun the large fluro pink flag will be lowered.

In the event of a ferry arrival/departure the race will be postponed until a start can be achieved safely. All boats must clear the starting area to allow ferry maneuvering.

8. SCORING:

The Low Points Scoring System, Appendix A & A9 will apply.

One race will be required to be completed to constitute a series.

No score will be excluded until **three** races have been completed and a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

Series results for each race will be counted in respect of boats entered only for the series. Individual entries shall be excluded when allocating points for the series.

8. PRIZES:

All participants are invited to attend the post race prize giving function held at the B.B.Y.C. Clubhouse after each race.
