Supplementary Sailing Instructions (SSI)

1 Rules (SI 1)

1.1 RRS Rule 29.1, **Individual Recalls** – the second sentence only is changed to read: "The flag shall be displayed until the hull of each such boat has been completely on the pre-start side of the starting line or one of its extensions, and until all such boats have complied with Rule 30.1 if it applies, but no later than 4 minutes after the starting signal or 10 seconds before any later starting signal, whichever is earlier."

1.2 Penalty at the Time of Incident (NOR 13)

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty. RRS Appendix P applies with the Two-Turns penalty replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

2 The Start (SI 9)

2.1 The race officer will *endeavour* to advise starting order via VHF channel 77 before the first warning signal. Failure to receive this transmission will not be grounds to protest.

3 Time Limits

- 3.1 For all divisions will be 2 hours from the divisions starting time.
- 3.2 An extension of 30 minutes will apply if 1(one) or more boats have finished inside the 2 hours.

4 Eligibility and Entry (NOR 4.2)

4.1 To qualify for a separate division, start and prizes a minimum of 5 boats are required to be entered before the first race.

5 Class Flags (SI 6)

5.1 [DP] All boats, shall display their class flag from the backstay of the boat, at least 1 metre above the deck line while racing so that it is clearly visible to other boats. Boats without a backstay shall fly their class flag from the port shrouds. Failure to clearly display the class flag may result in the boat being scored Did Not Start without a hearing. This changes RRS 35, A5.1 and A5.2.
